This invitation for bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this project that appeared in the Daily Newspapers, Project No. GY-L1066 of May 12, 2019.

The Government of Guyana has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) toward the cost of the Energy Matrix Diversification and Strengthening of the Department of Energy (EMISDE), and it intends to apply part of the proceeds of this financing to payments under the Contract for Engineering, Procurement, Construction & Installation, Commissioning and Turn-key Delivery of Solar PV Power Plants including Battery Energy Storage Systems for the Hinterland at Bartica and Lethem in two Lots.

The Project Coordinating Unit of the Guyana Energy Agency now invites sealed bids from eligible and qualified bidders for the Engineering, Procurement, Construction & Installation, Commissioning and Turn-key Delivery of Solar PV Power Plants including Battery Energy Storage Systems for the Hinterland at Bartica and Lethem in two Lots.
