

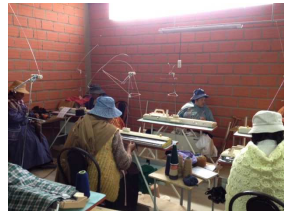
EYE ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

Bolivia: Program to Support Employment II (BO-L1121)

Challenge: The Bolivian labor market faces important challenges in terms of productivity and access to formal and better paid jobs. Employment assistance services play a central role in addressing the problems that Bolivians face: the gap between skill supply and demand, the lack of information, and the specific obstacles vulnerable groups face in their search for jobs.

Objective: The objective of this operation is to improve the workforce integration, in formal economic units, of job seekers who use the Plurinational Employment Service of Bolivia (SPEBO).

To achieve these objectives, the following components will be implemented: (i) Improve SPEBO's coverage and position; and (ii) Improve services for job seekers and diversify the supply of Active Labor Market Policies. The component includes the development and implementation of three pilot projects aimed at improving the integration of women, people with disabilities, and young people into the workforce.
