Dear Requesters,

Thank you very much for your time and our recent phone call.

After receiving your Request, on May 15 and within five working days marked under our Policy, we have reviewed the documentation and found that there is still missing information needed to register your complaint.

We have produced a Requirements Table to help you identify specifically what information we need and why. Among the requirements, we emphasize that the MICI is a last resort instance and therefore first contact with IDB Management. For this reason, while gathering the information identified in the Requirements Table, you must get in touch with them. Here are the contact details and actions to be taken:

1. On the IDB team for the Program are Mr. Oscar Camé (OSCARLUIISC@iadb.org), Juan Martínez (JANTONIOMA@IADB.ORG) and José Luís de la Bastida (JOSEDB@iadb.org). They are the ones who should forward your concerns initially.
2. If you do not receive an answer or the answer is not satisfactory, you can return to MICI for which it would be necessary to complement your Request with the missing information.

Therefore, I notify you that the administrative processing of the MICI-BID-BR-2020-0154 is closed at this point. This is not an impediment to re-presenting a Request once you have pending information.
