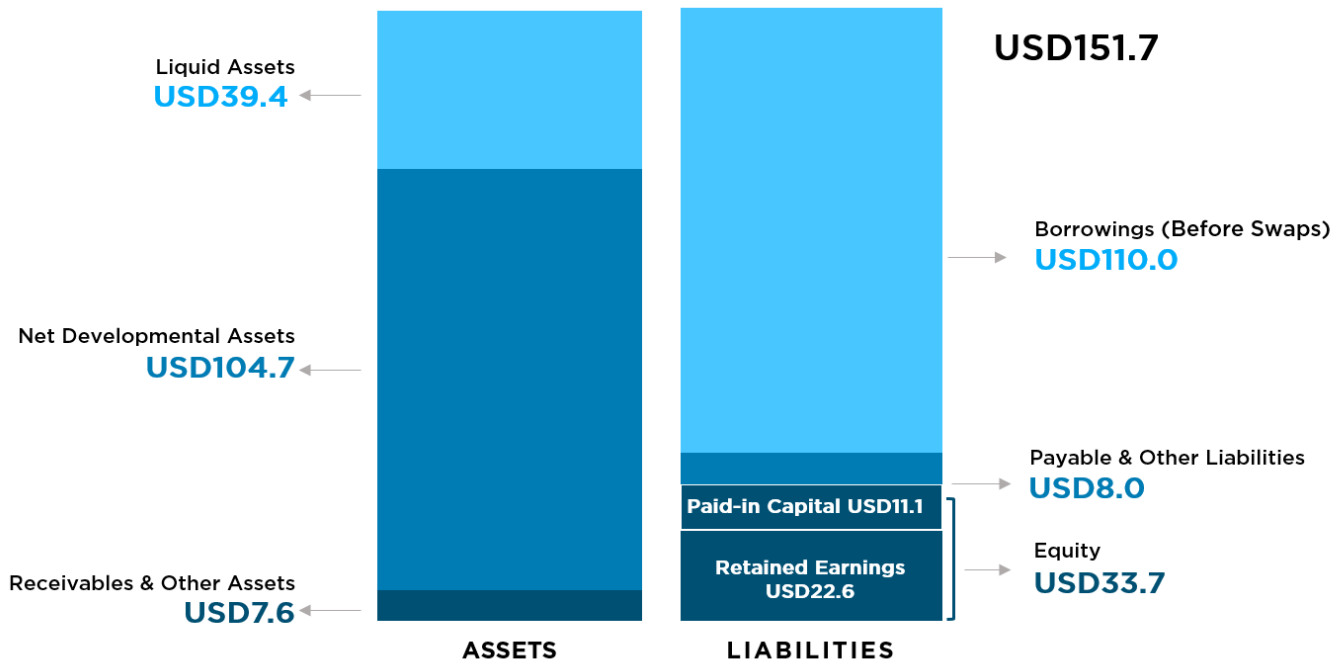


» 2020 Information Statement: Continued growth in Developmental Assets and Borrowings

In this challenging year, the IDB increased its support to its member countries, disbursing USD14.8 billion to finance development projects and to alleviate the effects of the Covid-19 crisis while maintaining sustainability and a strong financial standing. IDB's loan portfolio grew to USD104.7 billion in 2020.

IDB increased the lending spread applicable in 2021 of its sovereign-guaranteed loans from 80 bps to 90 bps to further strengthen its financial resilience aiming to preserve its lending and operational capacity. IDB expects to remain the main source of multilateral lending to countries in Latin America and the Caribbean with disbursements projected to exceed USD15 billion in 2021. In March, the IDB group held its week-long [Annual Meeting](#) in Barranquilla, Colombia in virtual format. The agenda was focused on themes such as the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, climate change, women's economic empowerment, innovation, health needs and the role of the private sector.

In addition, the [Board of Governors approved a resolution on recapitalization discussions](#), authorizing the analytic work required for a potential capital increase in the future.

Other highlights and initiatives:

- Launched an initiative for [Sustainable development of the Amazon region](#) to explore public and private investment opportunities for the countries of the Amazon.
- [2021 Macroeconomic Report](#) released discussing needs and growth opportunities for the region to set the stage for a more robust and sustainable post-Covid recovery.
