This Invitation for Bids follows the General Procurement Notice for this project that was published in Development Business Online, Reference No. IDB1659-12/17 of 22 December 2017.

The Government of Jamaica has received financing from the Inter-American Development Bank (IDB), Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and European Union-Caribbean Investment Facility (EU-CIF) toward the cost of the Energy Management and Efficiency Programme (EMEP), and intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments under the Contract for the design and build of seven (7) Government hospitals – 2.1.1/EU.

The Ministry of Science, Energy and Technology (MSET), now invites bids from eligible and qualified bidders for retrofitting seven (7) hospitals in Jamaica to reduce their energy consumption and GHG emissions based on an international competitive bidding process that will be evaluated based on a quality and cost effectiveness approach (using a Cost-plus approach).

Bidders eligible to participate are those who are nationals of member countries of the IDB and/or EU eligible countries.
