Description of Services: *The consultant will be required to prepare a plan and designs for the closure of Riverton Disposal Site considering technical, environmental, and social aspects. This assignment will serve as a template for closure of other waste disposal sites in Jamaica.*

The Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) is executing the above-mentioned operation. For this operation, the IDB intends to contract consulting services described in this Request for Expressions of Interest. Expressions of interest must be delivered using the IDB Portal for Bank Executed Operations (<http://beo-procurement.iadb.org/home>) by *June 7*, 5:00 P.M. (Washington D.C. Time).

The consulting services (“the Services”) include *preparation of closure plans and designs for the Riverton Disposal Site. Expected activities include: (i) Review of available information and site assessment; (ii) Development of Riverton Closure Plan, including a report and drawings that will have considered the operational history of the site (including the principal waste types accepted, such as municipal, industrial and hazardous waste); historic monitoring activities and reports; the site’s current usage and closure, considering the continuous operation of the site for at least 4 more years (if the previously defined available space allows it), while a new landfill site is selected, designed and becomes operational. The consultant will also consider traffic conditions, potential for gas capture, and storage, local climate, hydrogeology, topography of the site and clearly state the reason(s) for implementation of all their recommendations.*

The consultancy is expected to start by the last quarter of 2021.

Eligible consulting firms will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Inter-American Development Bank: [Policy for the Selection and Contracting of Consulting firms for Bank-executed Operational Work](#) - GN-2765-4. All eligible consulting firms, as defined in the Policy may express an interest. If the Consulting Firm is presented in a Consortium, it will designate one of them as a representative, and the latter will be responsible for the communications, the registration in the portal and for submitting the corresponding documents.

The IDB now invites eligible consulting firms to indicate their interest in providing the services described above in the draft summary of the intended Terms of Reference for the assignment. Interested consulting firms must provide information establishing that they are qualified to perform the Services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Eligible consulting firms may associate in a form of a Joint Venture or a sub-consultancy agreement to enhance their qualifications. Such association or Joint Venture shall appoint one of the firms as the representative.
