Description of Services: The Consulting Firm (CF) will be required to conduct a Water Audit of production, system input, transmission, off-takes and losses on the Caroni South and North Oropouche systems; and the Hollis, Caroni North and Navet systems. The CF will also supervise the installation, performance testing and commissioning of bulk meters and data loggers on the Caroni South and North Oropouche System.

The Inter-American Development Bank (IDB) is executing the above-mentioned operation. For this operation, the IDB intends to contract consulting services described in this Request for Expressions of Interest. Expressions of interest must be delivered using the IDB Portal for Bank Executed Operations (<http://beo-procurement.iadb.org/home>) by **May 23rd, 2022**, 5:00 P.M. (Washington D.C. Time).

The consulting services (“the Services”) include: ***the supervision of the installation, performance testing and commissioning of smart bulk meters, pressure loggers, data transmitters, hardware and software and ancillary equipment on the Caroni South and North Oropouche transmission systems (the Water and Sewerage Authority [WASA] or through other contractors will be responsible for equipment procurement and installation). Setting up of automated data management system to audit production, system inputs, transmission and off-takes flows and pressures and losses on the Caroni South and North Oropouche and the Hollis, Caroni North and Navet systems (WASA will be responsible for the installation, testing and commissioning of these last three [3] systems). Setting up of a calibrated hydraulic model that includes the five (5) systems mentioned above that is linked to the data management system to produce dashboards and daily digital reports that can be viewed on multimedia devices. The data management system will be built on WASA’s existing system, which will be assessed for fit for purpose. Training of WASA personnel in data management, analytics, analysis, hydraulic modeling and system maintenance.***

The consultancy is expected to start on August 8th, 2022.

Eligible consulting firms will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the Inter-American Development Bank: [Policy for the Selection and Contracting of Consulting firms for Bank-executed Operational Work](#) - GN-2765-4. All eligible consulting firms, as defined in the Policy may express an interest. If the Consulting Firm is presented in a Consortium, it will designate one of them as a representative, and the latter will be responsible for the communications, the registration in the portal and for submitting the corresponding documents.

The IDB now invites eligible consulting firms to indicate their interest in providing the services described above in the [draft summary](#) of the intended Terms of Reference for the assignment. Interested consulting firms must provide information establishing that they are qualified to perform the Services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar conditions, availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Eligible consulting firms may associate in a form of a Joint Venture or a sub-consultancy agreement to enhance their qualifications. Such association or Joint Venture shall appoint one of the firms as the representative.
